General information

The following notes provide a simple overview of what happens to your personal information when you visit our website. Personal data is all data that personally identifies you. Detailed information on data protection can be found in our Privacy Policy below.

Data collection on our website

Who is responsible for the data collection on this website?

The data processing on this website is carried out by the website operator. Their contact data can be found in the imprint of this website.

How do we collect your data?

Your data will be collected when you provide it to us. This may be e.g. to collect data that you enter in a contact form. Other data is collected automatically when visiting the website through our IT systems. These are above all technical data (for example Internet browser, operating system or time of the page request). The collection of this data takes place automatically as soon as you visit our website.

What do we use your data for?

Part of the data is collected to ensure a flawless operation of the website. Other data can be used to analyse your user behaviour.

What rights do you have regarding your data?

You have the right at any time and free of charge to information about the origin, recipient and purpose of your stored personal data. You also have a right to correct, to request the blocking or deletion of this data. Furthermore, you have a right of appeal to the competent supervisory authority

Analysis tools and third-party tools

Data Protection

Information, blocking, deletion

You have the right, free of charge and at any time to rectification, blocking or deletion of Information about your stored personal data, its origin, recipients and the purpose of the data processing within the scope of the applicable legal provisions. Statutory data protection officer

Data collection on our website

Cookies

Our website partly uses cookies, which are small text files stored on your computer by your browser.

Cookies do no harm and contain no viruses. They serve to make our offer more user-friendly, make it more effective and safer.

Most of the cookies we use are so-called "session cookies". They will be automatically deleted after the end of your visit. Other cookies remain stored on your device until you delete them. These cookies allow us to recognize you and your browser the next time you visit.

You can set your browser so that you are informed about the setting of cookies and allow cookies only in individual cases, the acceptance of cookies for specific cases or in general exclude and enable the automatic deletion of cookies when closing your browser.

Server log files

The provider of the pages automatically collects and stores information in so-called server log files that your browser automatically sends to us. These are:

- · Time of the server request
- IP address

A merge of this data with other data sources will not be done. The basis for data processing is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b DSGVO, which is the processing of data to fulfil a contract or precontractual measures.

Contact Form

If you send us inquiries via the contact form, your details will be taken from the Inquiry form including the contact details provided by you for processing the request and in the case of follow-up questions stored with us. We will not share this data without your consent.

The processing of the data entered into the contact form is thus exclusively on the basis of your consent (Article 6 (1) (a) GDPR). You can withdraw this consent at any time. An informal message by e-mail to us is sufficient. The legality of data processing operations remain unaffected by the revocation until the revocation occurs.

The data entered by you in the contact form remain with us until you request that we delete it, revoke your consent to its storage or the purpose for data storage is completed (for example, after completion of your request). Mandatory legal provisions - especially retention periods - remain unaffected.
